What You'll Do

As an Engage STEM instructor, you will primarily be part of our Distance Learning programming team. You will lead student groups through our well-reviewed "STEM Maker" curricula, modeling hands-on STEM activities and concepts for them. You will be responsible for following the curricula, making records of course progress, and ensuring students and teachers have the best possible experience. Personability and an appreciation of working with others is a must.

You will receive training in our instruction model and curricula before you are scheduled to lead courses yourself. You will also receive all of the STEM materials utilized in said curricula, and training in their function. You will have the opportunity to participate in other ongoing projects as their timing allows.

Where You'll Work

Your work will be fully virtual as an Engage STEM instructor. Those local to the OKC and Tulsa metro areas will have opportunities for in-person programming. There will be the potential for in-person conferences or similar travel once or twice a year.

- Youth programming experience (camp, museum, education setting, etc.)
- Core availability of 12 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Central Time
- High comfort level with new technology
- Willingness to continue developing skills
- Adaptable to unanticipated classroom obstacles (audio failure, school firewalls, etc.)
- Authorization to work in the United States
- Must be able to pass a background check
